What have we learned this week?

In Maths, we have been learning our number bonds to 100 using tens. We have been using our skills from previous weeks about related number facts to learn that our number bonds to 10 can help us find our number bonds to 100.

In English, we have been continuing to look at the story 'Ossiri and the Bala Mengro' by Katharine Quarmby and Richard O'Neill. We have started to look at what a newspaper article includes and have started to plan the: who, what, where, when, why information from our story.

In phonics we have been recapping, ge in large, g gym, dge in edge, kn in know, gn in gnaw and mb in thumb. We recapped reading the tricky words: improve, because, hour and through.

In our Feel the Beat learning mission, we have enjoyed learning about percussion instruments, pitch and beat. We are using the music, 'The Little Train of Caipira' as inspiration for our percussion.
